- Supporting Evidence (SAT)
- Rhetorical strategy
- Compare / contrast paired passages
- Tone of a portion (ACT)
- Data Analysis (SAT)

Big Picture - "MAPS"

(characterize aspects of the passage as a whole)

<u>M</u> = <u>M</u>ain idea **P** = author's **P**urpose $\underline{\mathbf{A}}$ = author's $\underline{\mathbf{A}}$ ttitude

<u>**S**</u> = passage <u>**S**</u>tructure

AKA - "Little Picture" or "Go Fetch"

(find and paraphrase information from a passage)

"passage states..."

"according to the author..."

(identify the meaning of words in context)
